Assignment of Benefits Agreement

Our Practice will accept an assignment of Benefits from your Insurance company with the conditions listed below.

It is important to understand that the agreement regarding your dental benefits is between you, your employer and your insurance company. The obligation you have with our practice is to pay for all treatment and services we provide to you, regardless of the amount that you may or may not be reimbursed by your insurance company. The following provisions identify our policies governing insurance claims.

- Completing Insurance forms is a courtesy we extend to you in an effort to save you time and to facilitate
 payment to our practice from your insurance company. By having our practice process your insurance
 forms, it is important that you understand that this does not eliminate your financial obligation for your
 treatment.
- We require you sign this agreement and/or any other necessary assignment documents that may be required by your insurance company. This instructs your insurance company to make payment directly to our practice.
- We require you to pay the estimated co-payment, which is the amount not covered by your insurance company, at the time we provide service to you. The co-payment is only an estimate of charges and may be adjusted after the time of treatment depending upon final reconciliation of insurance payment.
- Insurance payments are normally received with-in 30-60 days from the time of billing. If your insurance company has not made payment to our practice within 60 days, we will ask you to pay the entire balance at that time.
- Our Practice does not guarantee that your insurance company will pay for treatment you receive from our
 practice. We perform routing insurance billing procedures upon verification of coverage. However, if your
 claim is denied, you will be responsible for paying the full amount at that time.
- Our practice will not enter into a dispute with your insurance company over any claim. Although we will
 provide necessary documentation your insurance company requests to sort out any confusion or
 questions that may arise. We will cooperate fully with the regulations and requests of your insurance
 company. It is ultimately your responsibility to resolve any type of dispute over payments made or not
 made by your insurance company to our practice.

Dental Partners of Southwest Georgia Agreement to Use of Tooth Colored Fillings Additional Costs Involved

If you need a filling, as a treatment for restoring broken or decayed teeth, you have the option of selecting amalgam (silver fillings) or composite resin (tooth colored fillings). You <u>must</u> tell us at the time of treatment planning and review of costs, which type of filling you prefer.

There are additional costs involved with composite resin fillings. Insurance companies may only pay for composite fillings based on their charge for a comparable amalgam filling. If you choose composite fillings, you will be responsible for the difference between our charge for the composite resin filling and the amount paid by your insurance company for the comparable amalgam filling. This is standard procedure accepted by insurance companies and is a result of your insurance company's reimbursements; not based on billing procedures.

Therefore, once we process the insurance claim, there usually will be a difference between the amount you paid to us at your visit, and any remaining copayment as determined by your insurance company. This means that after we receive your claim, you will still receive a bill from us for additional charges. We want to be as accurate, and as upfront as possible with you concerning costs. At the time of treatment planning and review of costs, we cannot give you the exact additional amount that will be billed to you because we are unable to determine the amount accurately at that time, based upon the way different insurance companies reimburse for composite fillings. Therefore, we can only give you an estimate.

I have read and understand the above statement. By signing this agreement, I agree to the use of composite resin for my fillings, as well as the additional costs involved. I also understand that Dental Partners is in no way trying to persuade me into a particular type of filling and is only providing me with treatment and financial options.
